This 62-year-old male with a history of diabetes and peripheral vascular disease reported a 28-month history of a right foot wound secondary to trauma from stepping on a plastic safety razor covering while in the bathroom. Later, the wound became edematous and the patient developed fevers and chills. He was admitted to the hospital and later re-hospitalized secondary to a fever with wound sepsis. His wound cultures were positive for MRSA and risk for surgical amputation was discussed. The patient was referred to HyOx Medical Treatment Center and participated in 60 hyperbaric oxygen treatments.

**Result:** No amputation was required and the patient went on to heal.
