The patient, a 43-year-old, female with diabetes underwent a right fifth metatarsal head resection with ulcer excision. The patient was admitted to the hospital two months later, secondary to increased drainage from the right fifth toe area, and was diagnosed with right fifth toe osteomyelitis and gangrene. The patient underwent a fifth ray amputation and remained hospitalized for a week. A week after discharge, she was readmitted to the hospital secondary to gangrenous necrosis of the right lateral foot. The patient underwent debridement and was referred to HyOx Medical Treatment Center where she participated in 52 adjunctive hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments.

Result: Healing.
